

This place on the James River is about a 30-minute drive inland from Colonial Williamsburg. I'm sure it was Virginia ham and not turkey. Previously, two different Spanish Conquistadores had offered prayers of thanksgiving as well. The fall foliage goes on for 2-3 months down here as the oak leaves don't fall. 
