

## From Your Pastor

On Sunday, November 25<sup>th</sup>, **Melissa Buskey will be baptized** at the 11 a.m. service. It is a wonderful moment when one steps forward to publicly proclaim her faith in Jesus Christ. Plan to be present to rejoice with and support Melissa.

In December, we celebrate the **season of Advent**. In this season as we prepare to celebrate the birth of Jesus and remember what God has done, we also look forward to what God is yet to do.

I will focus on several scriptures from Isaiah and Matthew. The prophecies of Isaiah will challenge us to imagine what dramatic things God is yet to do. Can you imagine a world without war? A place where "lion and lamb" (the powerful and powerless) lay down (live peacefully) together?

The stories from Matthew help us realize ways God has already fulfilled his promises. We read verses such as "All this took place to fulfill what had been spoken by the Lord through the prophet:..." (1:22) "Jesus answered them, 'Go and tell John what you hear and see: the blind receive their sight, the lame walk, ..." (11:4-5)

Faith calls us to live between the promises of God and the fulfillment of those promises. In this season we realize that God has acted, is acting and there is still much God has promised to do.

In a world where war, poverty, scandal and corruption are almost accepted as natural, where is our hope? where do we place our trust?
