

"To my friends at First Baptist ~ Again I take the time to write to you . . . Today, May $31^{\rm st}$, is the $51^{\rm st}$ anniversary of my father's death. I am presently engaged in writing a short novel about his life. It will cover all aspects of his life including his military service.

I have completed seven chapters (forty-one pages) and the preface as of today. Parts of the short story I wrote and references to my mother's book, "God's Love Is Eternal," will be included.
