#### **A Note from Thelma Buckley (dated Wednesday, July 23, 10:27 p.m.)**

Don passed away at 1:40 pm as I watched him. He had been closing down all morning periodically. The heart beat would be down to almost 0, but he’d jerk his shoulders and would again be breathing. He has not been breathing normal for 3 days even though he was still on the trach. I read chapter after chapter of the Psalms and New Testament yesterday and today. The nurses said they were sure he could hear me; but, of course, he did not respond in any way. This afternoon I reached over to him and told him it was Ok to go, I still loved him, and that I can really go on. It seems that after that he decided to close down all the way and I noticed his breathing machine said 0 for several minutes. I called his nurse in, she checked him, and said Yes he is gone. Last week the doctors told me that if he did overcome this and was able to breathe on his own, he would be in a nursing home for the rest of his life. I know he would not have wanted that as we talked about that kind of situation several times in our past, so I’m glad he died peacefully like he did today. *It was hard for me to watch all this, but after awhile I was able to accept the fact that he was gone and I was alone. I knew it was coming as the doctors told me to be prepared for it many times even in the beginning. I am planning a Memorial Service for Saturday, August 2<sup>nd</sup>, in the Slatington First Baptist Church, Slatington, PA where we have been members since before 1995. They really have accepted us, and they especially have enjoyed the few times that Don offered the sermon in Jim Levan’s absence. We grew to be a very good family in church and I have in the Women’s Group. Don has always told me he wanted me to wear Green for his memorial service. So I am recommending that to my family, too. He likes roses, but he especially would prefer donations given in his name to the church you attend, to Habitat for Humanity, or to*

the National Wildlife Federation. These he has given to many times in our past. They can be found on the internet. This is all hard, but I know he is with the Lord and seeing many relatives and family there. –Thelma

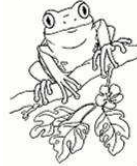
