Mark your calendar for Sunday, September 23rd when our own Cindy Mapstone will be our guest speaker for ABW Sunday.

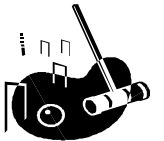
Special Mission Offering for ABC/NYS
